All students with an average of 98% and higher will be considered for this honor. Please see page 3 of the application package for the grading conversion.

Please also be sure to include at least 2 extracurricular activities that do **not** include American Youth Football. The following are examples of extra curricular activities that will be accepted:

- Religious Leadership roles
- Charity Work
- Community clean-up projects
- Recycling Programs
- Youth Programs I.e. Boys & Girls Club

Ensure that the application is fully completed. Only application that are filled out correctly will be considered.

Please submit your AAA application to your conference board by December 15<sup>th</sup> 2010 for verification. Conferences will then be required to send all verified application to AYF by January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011. AYF will announce all AAA award recipients in mid April 2011.

AAA recipients are chosen on the basis of academic achievement as well as extra-curricular activities and awards. All AAA recipients will receive a certificate to mark their achievement. A selection of exceptional students will receive a scholarship reward ranging from \$500-\$2,000.
